Currently he is Consultant (Psychiatry) (Part Time) at Kowloon Hospital as well as Honorary Consultant at Hong Kong Sanatorium & Hospital.

Dr. Wong is a specialist in Psychiatry. She is currently a private psychiatrist in Hong Kong Mind Wellness Centre and a part time psychiatric associate consultant of Kwai Chung Hospital. She previously worked as associate consultant in psychogeriatric team at United Christian Hospital and she has special interest in psychogeriatrics and dementia assessment tools.

Dr. Leung Lam Ming, Jess Psychogeriatrician in Private Practice

Dr. Jess LEUNG is a psychiatrist, sub specializing in old age psychiatry. She is the vice-president of Chinese Dementia Research Association, and is the honorary lecturer at both HKU and CUHK. She serves as a member in the Guardianship Board of HKSAR. She has special interest in the clinical intervention and research on dementia, delirium, elderly depression and issue related to mental capacity.

Dr. Rhoda Yuen Clinical Psychologist

Dr. Rhoda Yuen, Ph.D. has extensive experience in providing psycho-spiritual care as a counseling psychologist to terminal patients. Dr. Yuen had been serving the terminal patients and their families for more than 10 years at Bradbury Hospice. In the past 20 years, she regularly conducted professional training courses on counseling older adults, dementia care, end-of-life care issues and reflective workshops for health care professionals working in Hospital Authority, NGOs and the private sectors. She was the consulting psychologist for the Palliative Care in Residential Care Homes for the Elderly Pilot Project and Jockey Club Home for Hospice.

She is now in private practice and continues to be actively involved in palliative care and communication skills training.
