Dr. CHAN Chun Chung is a Geriatrician with around 20-year experience, currently in private practice. He is a specialist in Geriatric Medicine and Advanced Internal Medicine and also a trainer in Geriatric Medicine and Advanced Internal Medicine (Hong Kong College of Physician). He has special interest in dementia and has been the trainer and course instructor for many medical bodies and community organizations.

Mr. LEE Ching Kit, John is an Occupational Therapist (OT) with around 20-year experience in psychogeriatric and dementia service. He had been the committee of Psychogeriatric Working Group, OT Coordinating Committee of the HK Hospital Authority and had collaborated with OT clinical experts to develop OT Clinical Reference for Older Adults with Depression and OT Clinical Reference for Older Adults with Major Neurocognitive Disorder. He also is the Convenor of Psychogeriatric OT Service Model. He is a certified trainer in DementiAbility Methods: The Montessori Way and a certified Remotivation Therapy Instructor.”

Nurse Specialist (Psychogeriatrics), Kwai Chung Hospital

Mr. HO Chi Wang is the first Hong Kong psychiatric nurse overseas trained in psychogeriatric nursing. He had contributed to set up the first psychogeriatric assessment unit in CPH. Since 1994, he took up the role of a principal lecturer for the psychogeriatric nursing specialty course organized by the Institute of Advanced Nursing Studies, Hospital Authority. From 2008 to the present, he is designated as the chief lecturer and co-ordinator for the mental health module of the High Diploma of General Nursing organized by CMC nursing school. In KCH, he is a clinical instructor and mentor for the HKU and CMC nursing students.

Social Worker and Family Therapist

Ms. YUNG Lai is a family therapist and a social worker who works extensively with the elderly and the chronic patients for more than twenty years. She is expert in adopting self-help approach and family therapy in providing psychosocial support for the clients.
